- ❖ India is the largest democracy in the world, the 7th largest Country in the world, and one of the most ancient civilizations
- ❖ India never invaded any country in her last 10,000 years of history
- The medical system, zero, decimal system, Algebra, Trigonometry, Calculus, Chess, Yoga and Ayurveda originated in India
- ❖ The world's first university with medical school was Taxila − 700BC
- \* India was the largest economy/richest country till the British invasion
